

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHBURN COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE EXPIRATION DATE FROM JANUARY 1, 2002 TO JANUARY 1, 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA:


1. That the heading of the "Washburn Community Antenna Television Ordinance" and SECTION III be amended to change fifteen (15) year term specified therein to twenty four (24) years.
2. That Section XVII of said Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

"Section XVII -- DURATION AND RENEWAL OF ORDINANCE.

The rights granted to Grantee herein shall, except as provided in this Section, terminate twenty four (24) years from the effective date of this Ordinance, which Ordinance shall be subject to renewal pursuant to the provisions of the Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984 applicable to new ordinances that are in the nature of a franchise. Pending final completion of renewal proceedings, the Ordinance shall remain in effect even if the original twenty four (24) year term has expired. If this Ordinance is not renewed or if it is revoked for cause by the City, the transfer of Grantee's system shall be governed by Section 627 of the Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984."

An ordinance amending the Washburn Community Antenna Television Ordinance to change the expiration date from January 1, 2002 to January 1, 2011.

Be it ordained by the city Commission of the city of Washburn, North Dakota:

1. That the heading of the "Washburn Community Antenna Television Ordinance" and SECTION III be amended to change fifteen (15) year term specified therein to twenty-four (24) years.

2. That Section XVII of said Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

SECTION XVII - DURATION AND RENEWAL OF ORDINANCE

The rights granted to Grantee herein shall, except as provided in this Section, terminate twenty four (24) years from the effective date of this Ordinance, which Ordinance shall be subject to renewal pursuant to the provisions of the Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984 applicable to new ordinances that are in the nature of a franchise.
