

Ordinance Number 24.

An Ordinance Granting The Right Of Way To The Hughes Electric Company, Through Lounsberry Avenue, Village of Washburn, N. D., For The Purpose of Constructing and Maintaining On Said Lounsberry Avenue, A Long Distance Telephone Line.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees, Village of Washburn, North Dakota;

Section 1. That the Hughes Electric Company, a corporation, is hereby granted the right of way for a long distance telephone through Lounsberry avenue in said village of Washburn, N. D., for the purpose of setting poles and stringing wires thereon, subject, however, to the restrictions and conditions following;

1. Sufficient space shall be left for sidewalks between telephone poles and abutting lots.

2. The location and change of such line shall at all times be subject to the control of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Washburn and their successors in office.

3. All telephone wires at street crossings shall be strung at least 25 feet above ground.

4. This grant shall be and remain in full force and effect for a period of twenty years from and after the passage and approval hereof, and no longer, subject to each and all the foregoing restrictions and conditions.

Section 2 All notices required to be published under this ordinance shall be published but once and shall be deemed complete on the day of publication thereof.

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Village Council, held July 5th, 1905.

Passed August 9th, 1905, at a regular adjourned meeting of the village Board.
