

Ordinance Number 28

An ordinance granting the right of way to the Oliver County Telephone Company, a Co-partnership consisting of Charles Henry Wilcox, Clarence Elmer Wilcox, Burton Steven Wilcox and Roy Loran Wilcox, thru the streets and alleys of Washburn, North Dakota, for the purpose of construction and maintaining a telephone line.

Be it ordained by the City Council;

Section 1. That the Oliver County Telephone Company is hereby granted the right of way through the streets and alleys of the said City of Washburn, for setting poles and stringing wires thereon as will be necessary to connect with the telephon exchange of the Washburn Telephone Company, and the office of the Bismarck Elevator and Investment Company their heirs or assigns, subject to the restrictions and conditions following.

1. Suffieient space shall be left for sidewalks between telephone poles and abutting lots.

2. The location and change of said line at all times shall be subject to the control of the City Council of the City of Washburn and their successors in office.

3. All telephone wires shall be strung at least twenty-five feet above ground at crossings.

4. This grant shall be and remain in full force for a perion of twenty years from and after the passage of this ordinance and approval thereof, and no longer, subject to each and all the foregoing restrictions and conditions.

Section 2. All notices required to be published under this ordinance shall be published but once and shall be deemed complete on day of publication.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in ~~force~~ full force from and after day of publication.
